Topic

English

For example, describing a character who is feeling hungry could be written like this; 'Her tummy rumbled and she licked her lips.'

Please practise spellings at home. We understand that lots of children have been leaving their spelling books at school. We have a new system to ensure that every child brings home their spelling book.


Maths

We will be focusing on the four operations this half term and applying them to different contexts. For example in money we will use the empty number line to add different amounts and take away to find how much change needs to be given.

We are having a big push on problem solvingtalk to the children about the problems they have been working on.

We have noticed that the children find it difficult to count backwards from a random number between 30 and 100 They also find it tricky to count backwards in jumps of ten. If you could practise at home it would very much be appreciated.
