The Early Years' Pupil Premium (EYPP) is a Government initiative that provides extra money for vulnerable pupils. Vulnerable pupils are identified as those who are in receipt of free school meals, looked after children and children who have a parent working for the armed services.

Speech and Language Therapist	Block of therapy for identified children	To promote speech and language development	Pupil progress meetings and therapist and teacher assessment
Lead Teacher for Parental Engagement	Supporting families to support their children's learning	For children and parents to feel supported	Pupil progress meetings, in particular PSED data.
