Learners at Work

Some highlights from across our school. Year 1 met musicians from Spitalfields this week, what a wonderful treat! Year 6 are enjoying making music in their drumming lessons this half term.

Rousseau class discussed why we should save the trees, they found it hard to learn when all the wood was taken out of their classroom!

Year 6 have been learning about life in the Caribbean as part of their learning about Windrush. They explored the reasons why someone might migrate to a new country. Marcia and Margaret visited them to share their experiences and answer questions about Jamaica and Grenada.

In Science, year 6 are exploring the role of blood, they modelled the exchange of oxygenated and deoxygenated blood cells and explored the components of blood by making their own models.

Year 1 have been reminding themselves of the story of Little Red Riding Hood they learnt in Reception, they took the roles of different characters, acted parts of the story and answered questions. As part of their English

and History topic, Hokusai class are learning about Oliver Twist, by Charles Dickens, they experienced what a Victorian school lesson would have been like.

Hockney Class had a gardening workshop where they looked at what is growing in our school garden.
