

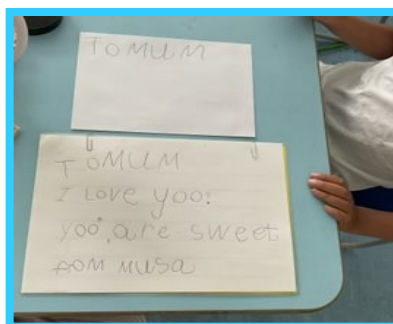
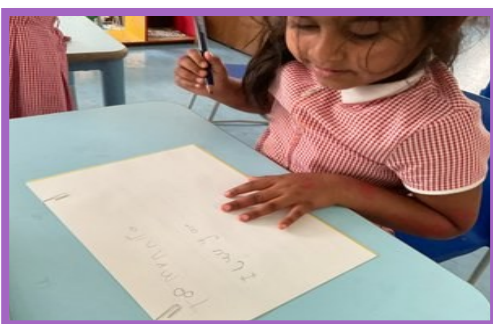

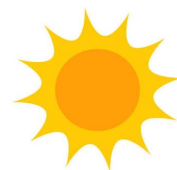
Whole School Attendance
