Tower Hamlets are coordinating admission to nursery from September 2019. If your child was born between 1st September 2015 and 31st August 2016 and you would like a nursery place for September 2019, you must now submit an online application to:

<u>www.eadmissions.org.uk</u>

by <u>17th February 2019.</u> Ask in the office if you need help. When you have completed and submitted your application you will receive an instant email confirmation. You can then make changes to your application up until the closing date: 17th February 2019. All children will now be offered 15 hours. To receive full-time Nursery in Tower Hamlets from September, working parents will need to claim for the 30 hours. Please ask Amena how
