We are always looking at ways to improve the learning and safety of our pupils. One of the ways we try to improve safety is by asking parents not to park their cars on Upper North Street. In Nursery and Reception, please wait by the door, the staff will call your child when you arrive. If you need to talk to staff please wait until children have been collected as this has to be their priority.



House points are awarded to pupils who follow The Mayflower Compass Points. Well done to everyone who was awarded house points this week.
