The needs of our pupils are a focus when planning for teaching and learning at Mayflower. Data and findings from sound research are used to identify the needs and to find solutions to diminish the difference that can occur in progress and attainment. We continue to look for opportunities that will support our learners. As a school and looking at research, we identified the Year 1 cohort as the most affected during the pandemic. We therefore decided to invest the Catch-up Funding to support reading across Year 1.

Focus:	Staff Lead	Cost
Specialist Key Stage 1 Teacher to support Reading: We hired a member of staff (who works part time at Mayflower and knows the children/school very well) for an extra day a week to cover our Year 1 teacher. Our specialist Year 1 teacher benchmarked the pupils and provided additional reading support weekly.	KS1 Phase Leader and the Reading Recover Team	£15,000
On line Reading Support A teacher met with targeted groups of children across the school to support with reading catch up. They met weekly and used an online reading platform to assist the learning.	English Lead	£5,000
Reading Recovery Teacher Support Children were identified and added to the reading recovery programme. The teacher worked alongside the class teachers to support reading.	Reading Recover Teacher/KS1 Phase Leader	£5,000
Investment in KS1 books The KS1 team identified books that would best support reading catch up in Year 1.	English Lead and KS1 Team	£2440
